DISSOLUTION OF A PARTNERSHIP

About this Document

This document provides instructions for dissolving a partnership in Nunavut, pursuant to the Partnerships Act.

Submission Guidelines

Be sure to read the document titled *Corporate Registries –Submissions Guide* (available from our website) so you understand the process, requirements and advantages of submitting your registration via email, and other submission options. The guide also explains how to complete the forms, and how to scan any additional supporting documentation that may be required.

Fees

There is no filing fee for this service.

Instructions

To dissolve a partnership, follow these steps:

1. Obtain and complete the Dissolution of Partnership form.

NOTE: The full name of the partnership must be provided.

- 2. Print the form and have every member of the Partnership sign the form.
- 3. Contact Legal Registries and provide a credit card number to which the registration fee can be charged.
- 4. Scan the form as an Adobe PDF (Portable Document Format) file at a minimum resolution of 300 dpi and email it as an attachment to CorporateRegistrations@gov.nu.ca.

Alternatively, the originally signed document may be forwarded by mail or by hand to Legal Registries at the address on this page (faxed delivery is not accepted).
